<p>LAS VEGAS VALLEY WATER DISTRICT CONTRACT NO. 454 2227 ZONE PIPELINE AND PRV NOTICE INVITING BIDS</p> <p>Sealed proposals for furnishing all labor, equipment, materials, and services required for the performance of the work specified by Las Vegas Valley Water District Contract No. 454 entitled "2227 Zone Pipeline and PRV" will be received at the office of the Clark County Purchasing Department, 10th floor, Clark County Bridger Building, 225 Bridger Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada 89155 until 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 18, 1986 at which time they will be publicly opened and read.</p> <p>Contract Volumes consisting of contract documents, specifications and reduced drawings, and sets of full-size drawings may be obtained at the above stated office of the Clark County Purchasing Department. The non-refundable cost for each Contract Volume is \$20.00. The non-refundable cost for each set of full-size drawings is \$5.00. Proposals shall be submitted on the sheets bound in the Contract Volume, and the complete volume submitted.</p> <p>The Contractor shall furnish all labor, equipment, materials, and services required for the complete installation of the pipeline and pressure reducing station. The site of the work is located within City of Las Vegas, City of North Las Vegas, and Clark County rights-of-way, and within easements obtained for the construction of the pipeline and pressure reducing station. The contract work includes all work required for the construction of approximately 2,860 horizontal linear feet of twelve (12) inch inside diameter asbestos cement pipe, 53 horizontal linear feet of six (6) inch inside diameter asbestos cement pipe, the installation of one 10'x4' PRV vault structure complete with valves, and all related valves, fittings miscellaneous connections and appurtenances. The planned pipeline and PRV station will be constructed within Lake Mead Boulevard right-of-way and acquired easements between Simmons Street and Tonopah Drive and extending east of Tonopah Drive.</p> <p>The Contractor shall be required to commence work under this contract within 30 calendar days after the date of the Notice to Proceed. All work under Contract No. 454 shall be completed within 120 consecutive calendar days after the date of the Notice to Proceed.</p> <p>Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes, Chapter 338, bidders are hereby notified that the prevailing wage rates established by the Nevada State Labor Commissioner must be paid to all workmen engaged in the performance of any public works contract awarded for the amount of \$100,000.00 or more. Said prevailing wage rates effective October 1, 1986, through September 30, 1987, as issued by the State by the State of Nevada, Office of Labor Commissioner, are included in the contract specifications.</p> <p>Prospective bidders must hold a valid license of a "Class" and a "Monetary Limit" corresponding to the work to be performed, in accordance with the provisions of the State of Nevada Contract's License Law.
