

Christmas Mailing Season

Mail Early in the Day and Early in the Month

Las Vegas Postmaster Joseph Ryan has announced USPS actions intended to minimize customer inconvenience and accommodate the anticipated Christmas heavy mailing season.

USPS will operate a courtesy Post Office located in the Boulevard Shopping Mall from Friday, December 5th through Sunday, December 21st. The Boulevard Shopping mall Post Office will be open Monday through Saturday from 12:00 noon to 8:00 p.m. and Sunday from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

In addition to the eleven "Classified" regular stations and branches in Las Vegas, 15 "Contract" Post Office units will be open at the following locations with respective times of service:

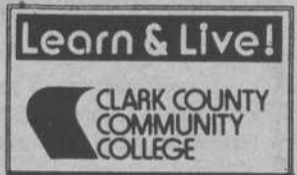

Ryan notes retail Postal Services are available Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. at the classified stations; and until 8:00 p.m. at the Airport Post Office.

Ryan advised that the mail processing facility located at 1001 Circus Circus Drive will be required to process three to four times the normal daily mail volume during the Christmas Mailing season and requests all postal customers "Mail Early." All Christmas cards should be deposited in mail receptacles no later than 10:00 a.m. daily.



Stamps By Mail Program Initiated

Las Vegas Postmaster Joseph Ryan announced that starting November 29, stamps by mail order forms will be delivered to every residence and business in the community.

The program was a resounding success last year and it is expected that many more customers will take advantage of it this year.

Simply complete the envelope as instructed, make your check or money order payable to "Postmaster" and include it in the special envelope provided. Fill In Las Vegas, NV 89114-9998 under Postmaster on the address side of the envelope and give it to your carrier or drop in any collection box.

Your order will be processed and promptly returned to you by your letter carrier.



Collection Of Mail Increased

Beginning December 3, sixty-five mail collection boxes located on major thoroughfares throughout the city will receive mail pick up every two hours beginning at 10:00 A.M. daily.

These collection boxes will be identified by a white Christmas tree painted on each side of the collection box.

Customers are urged to mail on their way to work or as early in the day as possible.
