## CCCC Practical Nursing Graduates Pass Licensing Exam with Above Average Scores

Paul Meacham, President of Clark County Community College and Alison McPherson, the Director of the College's Science and Health Division announced that the fifteen graduates of the last CCCC Practical Nursing class, who sat for the Nevada State Licensing examination, all passed with above average test scores. The required passing score was 350; the range of scores for the CCCC Graduates was 372 to 733. Their mean score was 505.5 which represents a 6.5 percent increase over last year's mean score.

The CCCC Practical Nursing is designed for the individual who desires an education with a career goal as a Licensed Practical Nurse

## Where Can We Reach Teens?

We adults have an urgent message for teens: too-early pregnancy and parenthood can hurt their future. But where can we most effectively reach teens with this message? Here are a few of the variety of suggestions we at the Children's Defense Fund have recently received from people planning to display our teen pregnancy prevention posters:

\* "at a health fair," writes a maternity-neonatal instructor for a nursing program;

\* "in the school library," suggests a librarian at a private school in Massachusetts;

\* "in a pediatric hospital emergency room," suggests a registered nurse;

\* "in my home economics classroom," writes an Iowa teacher;

\* "in the counselor's office;"

\* "our adolescent patient exam and waiting rooms," writes another registered nurse;

\* in Pennsylvania centers for adjudicated youths;"

\* "in an Alcohol and Drug Early Intervention/Prevention Program;"

\* "for our youth group at United-Congregational Church;"

\* "in our clinic which serves an inner city population;"

\* "in a secure detention home," writes a Norfolk, Virginia official working with teens;

\* "in a foster care/adoption agency," writes a New York social worker;

\* "in our church;"

\* "a state welfare office;"

\* "for our Methodist Youth group;"

\* "in the Healthy Start office in central Massachusetts," writes a state official involved in that state's effort to provide better prenatal care;

\* "in my Family Relationships and Child Development class as well as...the main lobby display case," writes a Pennsylvania high school teacher;

\* "for junior and high health classes" and "bulletin boards in the health room;"

\* "at 25 recreation centers" in Columbus, Ohio;"

\* "in our church Sunday school;"

\* "at a vocational high school."
