Diabetic Emergency Can Be Mistaken For Intoxication

The seasonal increase in drug and alcohol abuse can create the dangerous possibility that a diabetic emergency—either an insulin reaction or ketoacidosis—may be mistaken for intoxication

"Around this time of year, we are much more aware of the serious problems caused by alcohol and drug abuse, but most people are not aware that several of the symptoms of the onset of a diabetic emergency are easy to confuse with drunkeness or drug abuse," Nevada Affiliate President, Dr. Warren Evins. "Someone who appears drunk or under the influence of drugs could possibly be experiencing either a low blood sugar reaction (also called an reaction insulin or hypoglycemia) or very high blood sugar (ketoacidosis).

The symptoms of low blood sugar may include: sudden onset, staggering, poor coordination, anger, bad temper, pale color, confusion, disorientation, sudden hunger or sweating.

The symptoms of high blood sugar may include: gradual onset, drowsiness, extreme thirst, very frequent urination, flushed skin, vomiting, fruity or wine-like breath order or heavy breathing.
