"Gospel music is best described as raw, emotional sound," says Floyd Smith, lead singer for The Gospel Tornados. "It's a very physical feeling for the singer -- something within explodes and must be let out through song."

In honor of Black History Month, the Clark County-Las Vegas Library District will present The Gospel Tornados (Sunday) February 8 at 3 p.m. at the

Performing such songs as "When The Saints Go Marching In," "Morning Train," and "Amazing Grace," The Gospel Tornados repertoire contains songs whose roots were heavily influenced by black slave spirituals, colored by the blues and popularized by gospel groups since the late 19th century.

"Our style originated in Louisiana and Mississippi as most of the group is Southern born. We try to retain the original flavor of the best in honest original, soulful music," said Smith, who has been singing gospel music for over 50 years.

"Music and deep emotion are common to all men. People appreciate the singing. It helps them feel special."

The Tornados have been helping people feel special since its formation in Las Vegas in 1970 by the Rev. Johnnie Wilson. The group has performed extensively in most area churches and most recently at Jean, Nevada. They have also traveled throughout Louisiana, Texas and Arizona as well as performed in Chicago and Los Angeles. They have also cut several records as well as an album, "Don't Let the Devil Fool You."

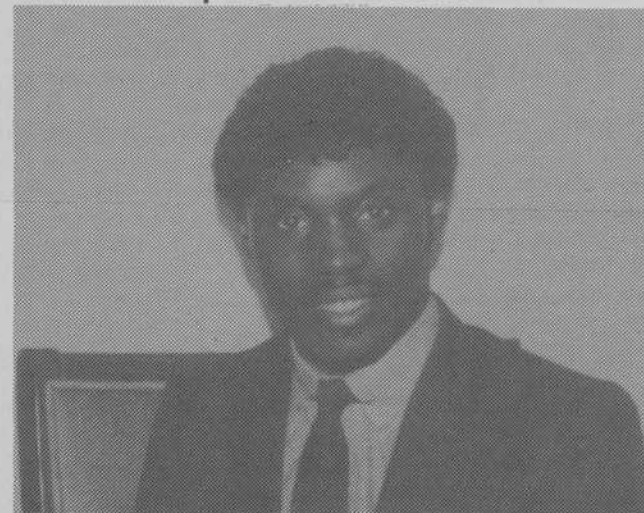
