# **Curry Faces Montgomery for USBA Jr. Middleweight Title at Caesars Palace**

Slick Rollin Williams of Phoenix takes on veteran Lorenzo Guzman of Las Vegas in a welterweight semi-main event on the Curry-Tony Donald Montgomery United States Boxing Association junior middleweight championship card Saturday, Feb. 7, at Caesars Palace.

Also on the card, promoted by Bob Arum's Top Rank, Inc., will be a pair of powerful and undefeated Las Vegas prospects, heavyweight Ed Duffy and lightweight Tim Mosley.

The six-bout championship card starts at 1 p.m. (PST) in the 4,298-seat Caesars Palace indoor arena. Doors open at noon, with the Curry-Montgomery USBA title fight scheduled to begin at approximately 2.

The Williams-Guzman fight is set for eight rounds, while Duffy, who meets Hector Fernandez of National City, Calif., is in a six-round bout, and Mosely, who takes on Gabe Sepulveda of Los Angeles, is a four-rounder.

The remaining two bouts feature junior middleweights Ismael Negron (6-3) of New York against Francisco Diaz (5-4) of Los Angeles in a sixrounder and heavyweight Jim Hoover (o-1), a security guard at Caesars Palace, against Las Vegan John Erloqua (1-1) in a fourrounder.

Former world welterweight champion Donald Curry faces perhaps the toughest and most crucial challenge of his career Saturday, Feb. 7, when he meets undefeated Tony Montgomery for the Boxing States Association junior

middleweight championship at Caesars Palace.

The scheduled 12-round bout for the vacant USBA 154-pound title matches Curry, the subject of many questions following his stunning loss to Lloyd Honeyghan in September, against Montgomery, highly regarded prospect who surpasses or equals the former welterweight king in 10 of 13 "Tals of the Tape" categories.

The championship card, promoted by Bob Arum's Top Inc., at Caesars Palace, begins at 1 p.m. (PST) Saturday, Feb. 7, in 4,298-seat Caesars Palace indoor Sport Pavilion. Doors open at noon with the Curry-Montgomery title fight scheduled to start at approximately 2.

The championship fight will be televised nationally by CBS, but blacked out in the Las Vegas area.

Curry, 25, won the World Association Boxing welterweight title February, 1983, and successfully defended five times. When he stopped his Boxing Council World counterpart, Milton McCrory, in only the second round in December, 1985, the new world welterweight champion was being proclaimed as one of the world welterweight champion was being

proclaimed as one of the two best fighters, pound-for-pound, in the sport of boxing.

But on Sept. 27, he was shocked by the unheralded losing his Honeyghan, undisputed championship in the sixth round.
