The highlight of the evening was the presentation of a plaque to Paul E. Meacham, President of the College, honoring him as the QPI Volunteer of the Year for 1986. Governor Announces Funding for Southern Nevada Jobs and Training

Governor Richard Bryan has announced that \$3,576,448 in federal funds will be available to help economically disadvantaged youth and adults in southern Nevada find jobs.

The money is part of Nevada's Job Training Partnership Act, Title II-A Program and will be administered by the State Job Training Office to local agencies based on the number of economically disadvantaged and unemployed in their area.

The program helps participants find out what type of jobs are available, with skills are needed and then provides on the job or classroom training to help them qualify.

The \$3,576,448 will be dispersed by the state to the Southern Nevada Employment and Training Program (SNETP) serving Clark, Lincoln, Nye and Esmeralda counties.

Governor Bryan also announced that the State Job Training Office has received \$2,326,779 for Summer Youth Job Training Programs, which will help nearly 2000 young Nevadans, between the ages of 14 and 21, find jobs.

Pre employment workshops, covering such basics as how to fill out applications, how to look for jobs, interviewing skills, how to be a successful employee and retain a job and what can be expected in the local job market in addition to a summer job, will be available to participants.

Summer Youth Program managers are always looking for new job sites. Southern Nevada employers interested in participating should contact the Southern Nevada Employment and Training Program at 885-6100.

Additionally Bryan announced that \$661,771 is being allocated to the Dislocated Worker Program, which will help nearly 700 Nevadans find jobs.

The program helps

displaced workers and people, who have lost their jobs as a result of layoffs and plant closures, obtain training, job placement information and even relocation assistance needed to get started again.

Nevada's Dislocated Worker Program is operated by the Nevada Employment Security Department.
