Jesse Jackson, candidate for President of the United States of America as standard bearer of the Rainbow Coalition, has appointed the ministers of Las Vegas headed by Rev. S.P. Parks and the elected officials headed by Senator Joe Neal to register more than 30,000 Blacks in Clark County and to get out the vote on election day. The Black political Steering Committee meets every Saturday morning at Grace

Immanuel Baptist Church at 9:00 a.m. and Victory Baptist Church on Monday at 7:30 p.m.
