to make business loans an equal opportunity sector. And programs providing for assisting minority enterprises should be expanded.

But as in many other areas, the black community needs to look to home-grown remedies as well. One might be community economic development efforts including the pooling of resources through church groups, neighborhood associations and similar groups. Such cooperative efforts can help to overcome the lack of startup capital and assure community support for businesses directed at consumers in black neighborhoods.

There's an important community role in building new businesses and in helping existing businesses to prosper and to become stronger swimmers in the mainstream economy.






