But as in many other areas, the black community needs to look to home-grown remedies as well. One might be community economic development efforts including the pooling of resources through church groups, neighborhood associations and similar Such cooperative groups. efforts can help to overcome the lack of startup capital assure community and for businesses support directed at consumers in black neighborhoods.

There's an important community role in building new businesses and in helping existing businesses to prosper and to become stronger swimmers in the mainstream economy.
