referenced story set forth in great details why the writer attempted to predict the future predicament of the Black man in America. To be sure the writer had no mathematical or scientific way of knowing that his foretelling will actually come true. However, the premise of his thinking is provocative and makes for some very enteresting reading. The writer began by saying at the present rate of death and other exclusions from the norms of the Black male gender, by the year 2,004 or within the next seventeen years the Black male population in America will be almost extinct. Even if the writer's predictions are only 121/2%, 25% or 50% right they would still be devastating. The reasons given are as follows: in part, namely drug and alcohol prison, AIDS, abuse. homosexuality, hypertension, military, fewer being born, (1 out of 3) killings, poor diet and poor health.

A Mass Black Male Extinction-

Although it costs approximately \$25,000 per year to house, feed, cloth and support a man in prison

educate him, America as well as Nevada appears to be hell bent on paying the higher amount. It's estimated that about one half of all the people in prison in the U.S. and in Nevada are Black and from 80% to 90% of those are Blacks between the ages of 18 and 45 years of age. And yet they are building more expensive large prisons in America and Nevada every year, all of which serves employment, and to a large extent, for white people. It seems to this writer that the trouble begins in the family and home. A lack of love, respect, education, caring and discipline make the young Black male ready target for an institutionalized racist system. After the Black male drops out of school due generally to lack of motivation, self esteem and support from home, he is not prepared to do anythingnot even fill out an application. While standing on the street corner unemployed, broke and hungry, he is ready to become a statistic.
