DOUBLE SESSION JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOLS: Woodbury JHS will dismiss at 9:05 a.m. June 4; Orr JHS will dismiss at 2:55 p.m. June 4.

SENIOR HIGH SCHOOLS: will end class June 4 at 11:10 a.m.

DOUBLE SESSION SENIOR HIGH SCHOOLS: Chaparral HS will dismiss at 10:10 a.m. June 4; Valley HS will dismiss at 4:00 p.m. June 4.

Teachers will be on duty Friday, June 5, for those students who need to make up tests: junior high school make up time, 8:10-9:20 a.m.; senior high school make up time 7:30-9:10 a.m.

Report cards are to be issued to students in nine-months schools, except in sixth grade centers. Sixth grade center report cards will be mailed to the student's home address.

The Helping Hand contribution to the Nevada Easter Seal Society will sponsor 10 children at the Severe Oral Language Pre-school Classroom in Clark County for a period of 10 weeks. Children with severe oral language disabilities need more intensive therapy than can be provided in the usual pre-school program classroom or individual once-a-week therapy setting. Early intervention, at the age of three and four years, may often prevent a child from being placed in a severe oral language classroom upon entering public school.

United Cerebral Palsy receives funding for transportation for 40 disabled children in southern Nevada to a camp for the developmentally disabled in Malibu, California.
