-City Election Returns Are In-

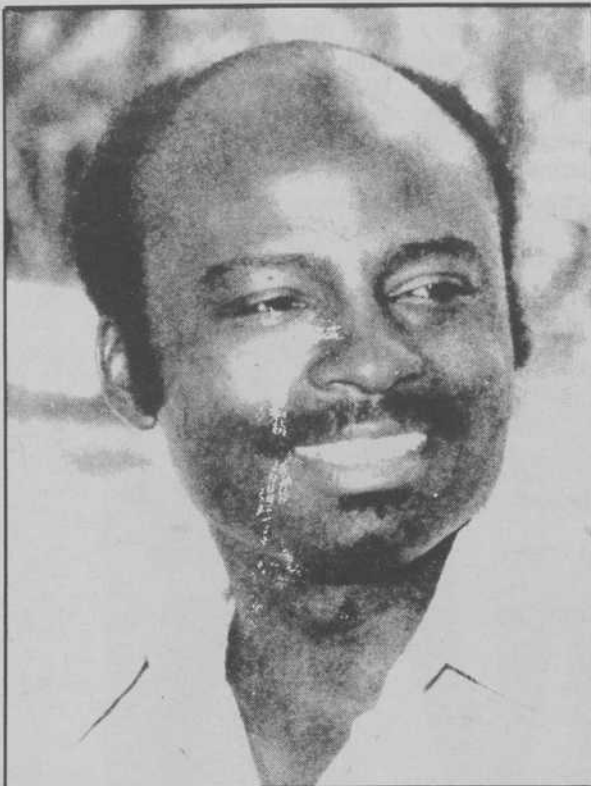
