having lost her home. Her rent was \$300 per month, doctor's visits had increased from \$10 a visit in 1981 to \$20, and an increased cost for clothing. So she had to return to the welfare rolls, which increased her monthly pay from minimum wage from \$436 to welfare of \$325 plus \$235 for food stamps, all medical coverage or a total of \$557

Another sad story was from a lady in Pennsylvania, where both she and her husband work in the same restaurant for the minimum wage. They started when the minimum wage was \$2.65 and the only raise they have received is when the federal government raised the wages. Their only benefits are one week paid vacation and workmen's compensation. Their son has a chronic asthma condition which requires expensive medical care. His medicine is \$84 per month plus several visits to the doctor at a cost of \$18 per visit. Her son had to see a specialist, at a cost of an extra medical bill of \$524. When she had an accident her husband worked her shift also. Whenever they try to get a better paying job, she stated that employers rather take an unemployed person than onne who is working.

The Administration's opposition to a minimum wage increase to keep up with the rise in prices runs counter to its fight for defense increases based on rising cost. Mr. Reagan seems to be more interested in fattening the coffers of weapons manufacturers than aiding the poor to rise above the poverty level.
