

WORDS OF LIFE "I sought the Lord, and he heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.' -PSALM 34:4

PRAYER POEM

That God answers public as well as personal prayers is evident in the hymn, "Lord of our life, and God of our salvation.'' It was written originally in German by Matthaus von Lowenstern in 1644, toward the end of the Thirty Years War

Phillip Pusey, a notable English gentleman farmer and member of Parliament, paraphrased von Lowenstern's words and provided their present form. The famous Jewish convert and Victorian Prime Minister, Disraeli, said of Pusey that he was "one of the most distinguished country gentlemen who ever sat in the House of Commons." A social reformer, he coined the phrase, "tenant-right."

Lord of our life, and God of our salvation, Star of our night, and hope of every nation, Hear and receive thy Church's supplication, Lord God Almighty.

Lord, thou cans't help when earthly armor faileth; Lord, thou cans't save when dead sin assaileth; Lord, o'er thy rock nor death nor hell prevaileth; Grant us thy peace, Lord.

Peace, in our hearts, our evil thoughts assuaging, Peace, in thy Church, where brothers are engaging, Peace, when the world is busy, war is raging, Calm thy foes raging.
