A fascinating element to the tutorial training workshops is the way in which the trainees assume the position of students. Ownership is a key concept in these workshops. The trainees (students) start off saying "My name is _____" as opposed to "I am _____." "My name" denotes ownership and generates pride. This device is designed to make the target group feel they are "SOMEBODY" right from the start.
