Hollings, who has called the South Carolina State NAACP and other organizations and individuals in the state of South Carolina who have opposed his early endorsement of Bork, lynch mob'' - a term that Ronald Reagan has adopted from Fritz Hollings - stepped up his attack to include national black leaders in his speech.
