

"He is not far from each of us."

—ACTS 17:27

I — Help is at hand! So often, in the face of difficulty, we tend to panic. Yet help is readily at hand, since "God is not far from each of us."

It is a truism in life that nothing that we actually need is impossible for us to attain. We need but separate our "wants" from our "needs" and then reach for the help we need . . . at hand.

II — Our answers are supplied. The psalmist was mindful of this, many centuries ago, when he held out for all to hear and heed words reminding us that all that we need has been granted in what God has already ordained, decreed, prepared. (See Psalms 103 and 150.)

III — God is waiting. Underneath . . . awaiting simply our call for help and dependence . . . are "God's everlasting arms." "O rest in the Lord. Wait patiently for Him; and He will give thee thy heart's desire . . . Commit thy ways unto Him and trust in Him . . ."

How gracious and how near to us is God. "He is not far from each of us."

In 1836, Edward Osler wrote a Communion hymn which speaks of God's nearness to us.

God is near to us in every sacrament, in every sign of His hand and heart and life.

Osler wrote:

O God, unseen yet ever near, Thy presence may we feel; And thus inspired by holy fear Before thine altar kneel.

Here may thy faithful people know The blessings of thy love, The streams that through the desert flow, The manna from above.

We come, obedient to thy word, To feast on heavenly food; Our meat the Body of the Lord, Our drink his precious blood.

Thus may we all thy word obey, For we, O God are thine; And so rejoicing on our way, Renewed with strenghth divine.
