## EOB ASSISTS SENIORS

Low Income Energy Assistance in the amount of \$2,040.597 is available to help needy families and individuals pay their utility bills.

Nevada residents who are low income can get help in paying a portion of their fuel or energy bills. Last year, the state was able to help more than 12,000 Nevada families through this program.

The program is open to anyone who is at or below poverty level guidelines. Application intake sites are located throughout Clark County. Nevada uses poverty level figures established by the federal government to determine the maximum allow-
