

## WORDS OF LIFE "Gather the weeds first . . . " -ST. MATTHEW 13:30

I. "Wash your hands and face . . . !" Company is coming. Or we are about to sit down to eat. But first, we must remove the unsightly and unseemly things. We want to be clean for company, for family fellowship and for friends. "Put on thy beautiful garments, O Jerusalem."

II. Weeds spread. They sprout out seedlings from their roots and choke out that which is good. Or, perhaps like dandelions, they use the winds to scatter their seemingly attractive seeds of destruction.

Some "weeds," in the form of vines, choke and kill the largest and strongest of trees. Hence, the wisdom of the divine words: "Gather the weeds first .

III. Good cannot grow where evil is entrenched. God asks us to dis-entrench life's weeds and thorns. God asks us to help Him, as He seeks to free us from the fetters of self-centeredness which hinder growth into the measure of the stature of the fullness of our life . . . in Him
