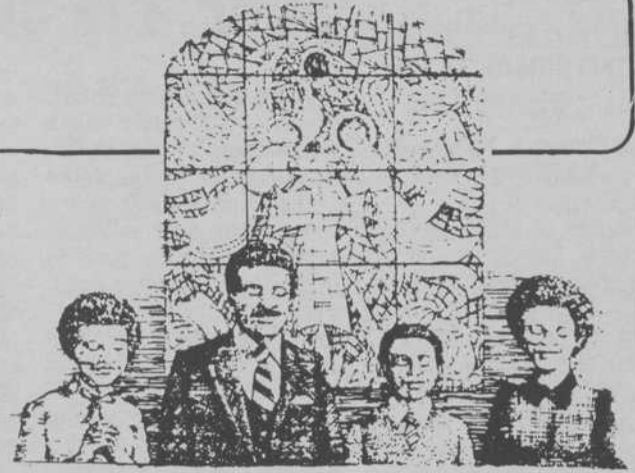

WORDS OF LIFE

"So God Created . . ."
—GENESIS 1:27

I. Living is creating. All throughout our lifetime, we are either growing creatively or we are withering on the vine. The choice of which we shall do is up to each of us.

To live is to create happiness, to create fresh pockets of sunshine, of peace, of joy, and of fulfillment. Are you living? Or are you simply withering the days away?

II. God sets the example. And what an example is His! He created the earth and heavens from a void. In other words, he took "nothing" and made it into something useful and "glorious." Are you using life? Or are you creating life? We are either parasites or we are benefactors.

III. When He got so far, God rested. Are you taking a break in your life's routine? Work and rest. Work and rest. Work and rest. Not necessarily the rest of idleness but the creative rest which comes from a change of pace.

On the Sabbath Day we must change our pace . . . in God's way. That brings creation to its crowning point, to its perfection.

Charles Wesley's hymn, "Love Divine," speaks pointedly of life as a movement of creation. Wesley concludes his hymn thus:

*Finish then thy new creation;
Pure and spotless let us be:
Let us see thy great salvation;
Perfectly restored in thee;
Changed from glory into glory,
Till in heaven we take our place,
Till we cast our crowns before thee,
Lost in wonder, love and praise.*

Our lives are perpetually being created and recreated. In this way, we move "from glory into glory."

For the Christian, "glory" is an ever-present fact. But its growth, its re-creation into greater glory, is the process by which we become "Lost in wonder, love, and praise."

Reagan appointees to the U.S. Supreme Court, along with two other justices, do not feel constrained by judicial precedent when it comes to upholding civil rights law . . . they are motivated by the Reagan philosophy that equal protection for minorities under the law should have no permanency in our society. history to review and possibly reverse those decisions that have laid the groundwork for equal justice under the law. We, the NBA, believe that this is judicial activism of the worst kind."
