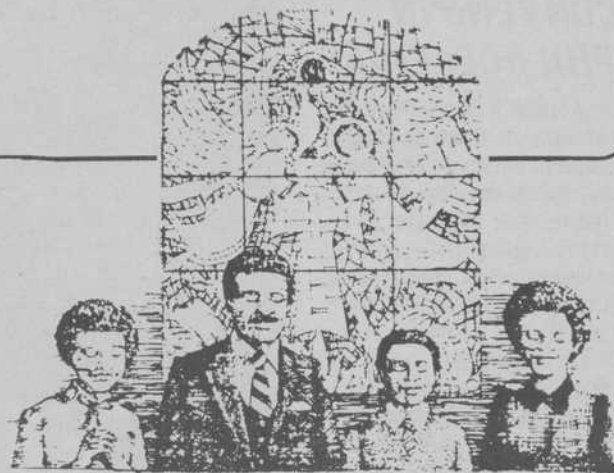

## WORDS OF LIFE

"Be aglow."  
—ST. JOHN 14:27

I. Let your glory shine! The Psalmist of old put a question to God as to the nature of man; and then he recorded the response. The Psalmist wrote: "What is man that thou are mindful of him . . . ? The answer: "Thou has made him to be a little lower than the angels and hast crowned him with glory and worship."

Where is *your* halo? Let your glory shine, as it should.

II. Our glory is God's glory. Our lives are all a part of God's life. His hands made us, and in a fine and wondrous way. Indeed, we are made in God's image. God shares His glory with us. "Be aglow" with the glory of God!

III. Smile! Not the superficial or plastic smile which ignores life's problems, perplexity and pain, but the deeper smile which recognizes that God stands within life's every shadow "keeping watch above His own."

Smile men; and we are told the world will smile with us. "Be aglow"; for God's glory fills and marks our lives.

### PRAYER POEM

The most familiar words which speak of the glory of God—a glory in which we fully share—are those of the "Gloria Patri" (Glory Be To The Father).

The words are ancient. But the tune to which they are conventionally sung was written in Baltimore by the German-born musician Christopher Meinecke (1782-1850). The words read:

*Glory be to the Father, and to the Holy Ghost;  
As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be,  
World without end. AMEN.*

Glory is the most persistent theme in all the descriptions or depictions of the life beyond. God's Throne is a "glorious throne." The heavenly city is said to have no need of light; "for the Lamb is the light thereof."

When we share—as is our inheritance when we were "born again"—in baptism—in God's life, God's glory is our lot.

Be aglow! Let God's glory shine through you!

Are you continually tithing and praising God for His glory? Speak with your pastor from time to time, regarding fresh and appropriate ways in which you may be aglow and show forth the glory of God.
