

NAACP AND RUN-DMC HOLD REGISTRATION DRIVE

BALTIMORE-The NAACP, in association with RUN-DMC one of the nation's hottest rap acts, will sponsor a national voter registration drive this spring and summer in over 50 major cities to register thousands of young black youth in time for the presidential election, Dr. Benjamin L. Hooks, Executive Director, has announced.

NAACP representatives will be present at the concert sites to register voters. Each new voter will receive a colorful poster featuring Dr. Hooks and Run-DMC. In addition, the popular group has recorded a public service announcement which will be played over the nation's radio stations urging young people to vote.

"We must help our young people understand that they have the most powerful political weapons in their hands. and that all it takes is for them to register and then vote," Dr. Hooks said.

"We are extremely happy to work with Run-DMC in

setting up registration tables at their concerts," Dr. Hooks added. "Just imagine, if we could get every young fan of these young men to register and vote, we would have accomplished more this year in the area of voter registration than we have done in the past five years!"

According to Rush Artist Management, which manages the group, Run-DMC is deeply committed to several social causes. "Our acts have always been distinguished by their social commitment, which is why they command so much respect from our fans," said Russell Simmons, president and founder of Rush management. "We would like to take advantage of this respect in this election year by working with the NAACP and registering tens of thousands of new voters," Simmons said.

This year's tour by Run-DMC will attract more than one million fans at over 70 performances. The 1988 tour kicked off in late May, and will run through late August.
