NEW LAS VEGAS MINISTER SOLICITS HELP

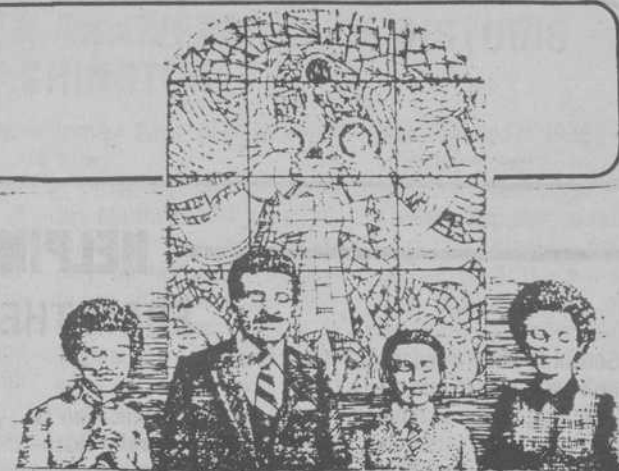
A new local female minister is asking for help in acquiring a building to house God's Temple Baptist Church.

Tearful Baptists Briefly Reunite In Dallas, After 73-Year Separation

Washington, D.C.
The two largest organizations of Black Baptists in the

world — the 8-million member National Baptist Convention and the 2.5 million-member National Baptist Convention, USA — came together in a brief but memorable show of unity in September in Dallas, Texas.

But, they declared, although this is the first time in 73 years, they had no present plans for rejoining the two conventions. However, they pledged to work together more closely in the future and would seek to establish a joint stand against apartheid in South Africa, and on other issues.

One hundred buses and a convoy of automobiles brought some 29,000 delegates of the smaller Baptist
