#### **Request For Proposals For** Engineering Services

The Las Vegas Valley Water District is requesting proposals for providing certain design, construction, and special engineering services for approximately 4 miles of water pipeline and water well pumping equipment and appurtenances for the Searchlight Water System. All work is to be considered to be one project. The entire project is planned to be operational by early 1990.

Proposal must consist of completed U.S. Government, General Services Administration Standard Form 254 and Standard Form 255. Proposals will be evaluated for past performance, staff resources, technical resources, financial resources, and other factors pertinent to the matter of time of performance which is of the essence to this project. Consideration for selection will be based on the assignment of 40% for Technical Resources, 20% for Staff Resources, 20% for **Demonstrated Technical Per**formance, and 20% for Demonstrated Project Management.
