

The paperscheme goes something like this: maybe 2000 whites live in the incorporated part of the town that receives the Federal disaster monies, while maybe 5000 African-Americans live on the outskirts of the town, an area not incorporated, and receive little if any aid.

While the Federal **Emergency Management** Agency has indefinitely extended its deadline for Federal disaster aid, accorjust a day away and not ding to the Columbia, S.C.

Urban League, many Hugo victims have not applied for the aid because they are either illiterate or suspicious of the government. A majority of the victims live in rundown rental housing and have landlords that show little interest in repairing them. The League is attempting to encourage the state to create a program to help all of Hugo's victims.


