Zora Neale Hurston, a black writer and folklorist, wrote stories and novels that celebrated the black experience in America's rural South. When her work first appeared in the 1930s, blacks were commonly viewed as inferior. Hurston rejected this perception, but she drew criticism from other blakcs for refusing to portray blacks as victims of this myth.

In a new production on American Playhouse, actress Ruby Dee pays tribute to the life and work of Hurston in "Zora Is My Name!" The program airs Wednesday, February 14, 1990 at 9:00 p.m. during public television's Black History Month.

Dee portrays Hurston and is joined by an all-star cast that includes Oscar Brown, Jr.; Louis Gossett, Jr.; Flip Wilson; Paula Kelly; Roger Mosley; Beah Richards; Count Stovall; and Lynn Whitfield.


