Wonder Testifies He Wrote Song

LOS ANGELES - Singersongwriter Stevie Wonder took the witness stand Thursday and testified he bagan work on the Oscar-winning song "I Just Called To Say Love You" after a 1976 visit to his mother.

Wonder's claim establishes the creation of the tune one year before songwriter Lloyd Chiate maintains he collaborator Lee Garrett played Wonder a tape of a song they wrote called "I Just Called To Say.

Chiate claims in his copyright infringement lawsuit that Wonder, who was sued under his true name of Steveland Morris, stole the tune that won a best song Academy Award for the 1984 film "The Woman in Red.

Wonder began testifying only after U.S. District Judge David W. Williams moved the trial to a larger courtroom to accomodate a crush of reporters and spectators who came to see the Grammywinning entertainer.

Under questioning by Chiate's attorney, Herb Dodell, Wonder said he began thinking about the song on July 16, 1976, while returning from a visit to his mother in the San Fernando Valley to his home at the time, the Regency Hotel.

Wonder said he developed "enough of a working idea for a verse and a chorus" to make a recording of the tune the same day, but "various things changed throughout the years" before the tune was actually completed and
