

**Foreman Enters Race for Title**

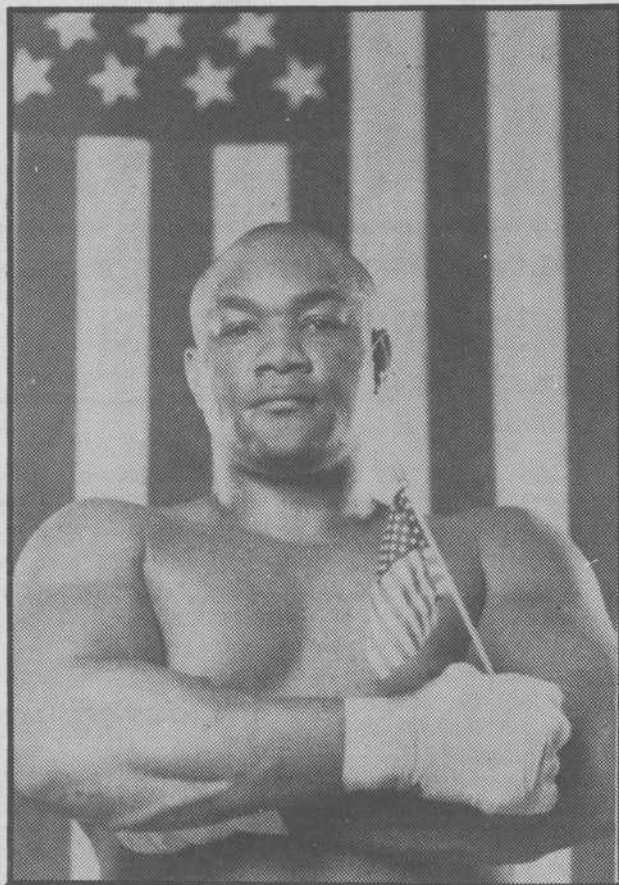
With plans for the "Buster" Douglas-EVANDER Holyfield fight still not complete, former heavyweight champion George Foreman feels that he should be the one to fight Douglas.

Foreman arrived in Las Vegas to attend a press conference held by Douglas and his manager John Johnson at the Mirage Tuesday.

Johnson made it clear that there weren't any plans to make any changes. "We still want to fight in September, we still want Evander Holyfield as the first choice as an opponent. After that we want to fight Mike Tyson again. Douglas' manager said he had not talked about a possible fight with Foreman.

However, Johnson also said that if negotiations for a Holyfield and/or a Tyson rematch broke down, that would leave the Douglas camp with no choice but to look for other fighters.

Johnson also stated that a Douglas-Foreman fight would be on about the same level as a Douglas-Holyfield bout.

**Jones Reportedly Paid for Car**

An ex-girlfriend of former UNLV standout Anthony Jones has reported that he never missed a payment on his sports car and didn't have a booster make payments for him.

The Los Angeles Times reported that a UNLV booster bought the Mazda RX-7 Jones drove during the 1985-86 season and made payments on it.

The booster, C.J. Lotter of Las Vegas told the Times that Jones worked for him. He also stated that he leased cars to some employees, provided insurance, and allowed for fluctuating payments.

The ex-girlfriend, who requested anonymity, said she had proof that she had made at least 10 of the payments, and that Jones

had made regular monthly payments. She said the car was a 1982 Mazda and the payments were either \$115 or \$150 a month.

The story was written by Danny Robbins, who reported a number of alleged violations in UNLV's recruitment of Lloyd Daniels. The story led to an NCAA investigation that is still pending.

**Officials to Meet Strawberry's Wife**

LOS ANGELES — Prosecutors said they would meet with the wife of New York Mets outfielder Darryl Strawberry to discuss a month-old domestic dispute that led to Strawberry's arrest for allegedly threatening her with a gun.

However, a decision on whether misdemeanor charges will be filed against him will not be made until after Strawberry gets out of an alcohol rehabilitation clinic, Los Angeles city attorney's spokesman Mike Qualls said.

**ABC Will Honor CFA Contract**

BOULDER, Colo. — The College Football Association agreed on new contracts with ABC and ESPN for \$50 million less than the deals that included Notre Dame.

ABC, which in January agreed to a five-year contract for \$210 million, accepted a new five-year deal for \$175 million. ESPN, which last fall agreed to a four-year contract for \$110 million, settled on a five-year contract for \$125 million.
