N'YORK CITY - Vincent Camby of the N'York Times gave the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences the back of his "Write Hand." His editorial temperature was seemingly lifted by the exclusion of Spike Lee's "Do the Right Thing." which in both our minds, should have received Oscar nominations for Rose Perez's acting and two for Spike Lee, "Best Director'' and ''Best Picture." 
