(7) provide Flight Information Display Ststem (FIDS), telephone communic and public address system, all as extensions of the existing airport systems as well as interior signage, and (8) complete interiors including refurbishment of existing areas to be reused, including, but not limited to, furnishings, interior painting, wall coverings, floor coverings. ceiling finishes and lighting.
