### UNLV All American Trevaia Williams Seeks Heptathlon Title at Big West Meet

Trevaia Williams, UNLV's returning All-American track star, who ran a leg on the 4x400 relay team at the outdoor championships in 1989, will attempt to gain yet another victory as a "Sprintin' Runnin' Rebel" this week as UNLV hosts the Big West Championships May 11-12.

A very versatile athlete, Williams has national championship potential in many events.

As a sophomore, she was a member of the victorious All Big West 4x400 meter relay team. She has also set the school record in the high jump leaping 5'10".

Williams attended M.B. Smiley High School in Houston, Texas, where she gained All-American honors in the high jump and 400 meter run. She was a two-time Texas State high school champion in the 400 meters, and was the state high jump champ her senior year.

The communications major also competed on the 1986 USA team.

### UNLV To Host Big West Track and Field Championships May 11-12
