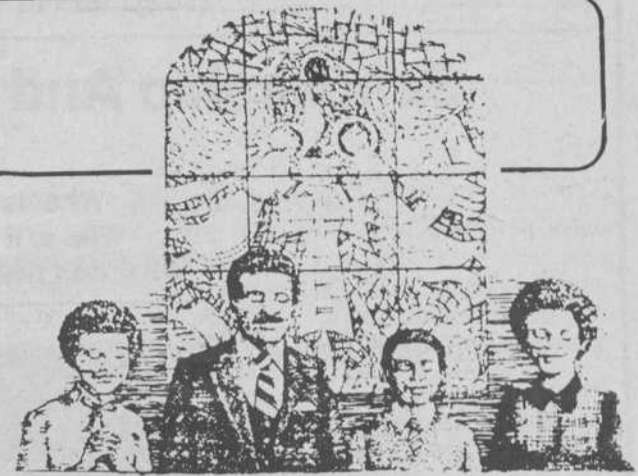

BIBLICAL INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

"Be not rash...nor be hasty." Psalm 141:2

1. **Be Calm!** If we lose our heads, it has been aptly said, we are sure to lose our case. Calmness quiets this impetus pounding of our hearts. It prevents us from acting prematurely, which is often the equivalent of acting immaturely. When we let our feelings "take control," instead of merely making suggestions to our minds so that the best overall judgements may be made, we are being rash...and so we tend to lose.

2. **Don't be too quick!** Trigger-happy people act too hastily; and they most often regret what they have done. The Scriptures well remind us to "rest in the Lord." Wait patiently for Him; and He will give thee thy heart's desire." That's the kind of antidote we all need at times to haste. Wait! Wait upon the Lord...and find our heart's desire in Him.

3. **"Easy does it!" Jesus said: Take my yoke upon you; for my yoke is easy and my burden is light. When we take upon us just the responsibilities that God would have us bear, then no step of our way becomes too difficult, no weight is ever too heavy for us.**

Take it easy! Don't be rash! Don't be hasty! Rest easy in the Lord! All will be well for you.
