

Bo Kimble Takes On Hollywood

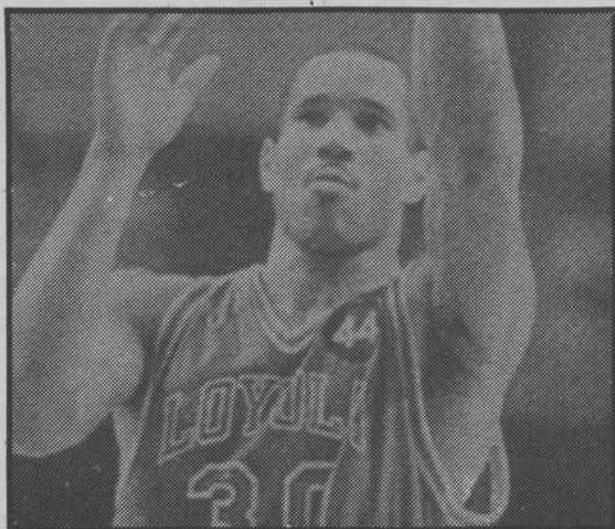
Bo Kimble, former Loyola Marymount University basketball star, recently completed his first film role.

Evander Holyfield on James "Buster" Douglas

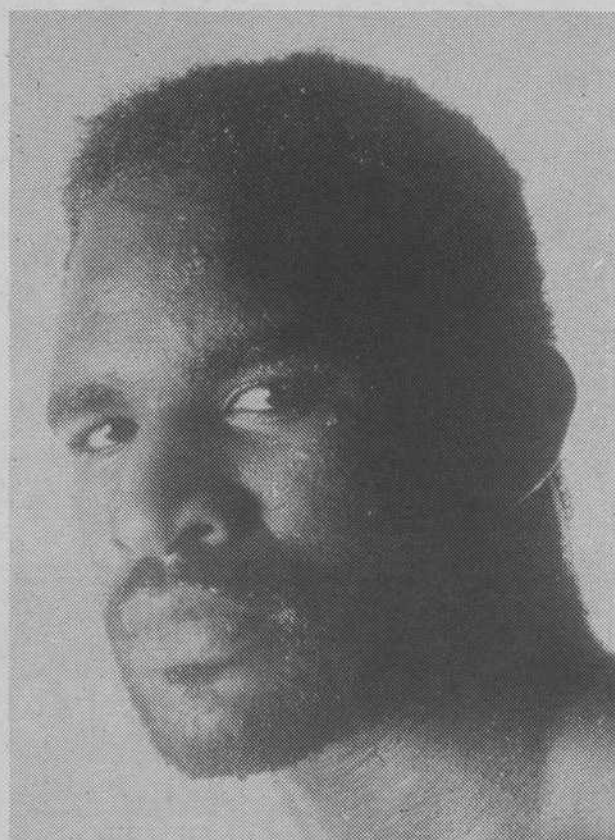
"Buster is a good fighter. He's a very skillful, technical fighter. But I will win the fight because I'm the better man. My ability to perform is what will make the difference. My experience, my technique and my ability to win will work together. The most important weapon I have is my mind.

"I feel that (Mike) Tyson let Buster Douglas do what Buster wanted to do. Buster dictated the pace. Buster opened the show. Buster closed the show. Buster was general of the ring. I have to be the general. I've got to make Buster realize, 'Hey, I'm not Mike Tyson and you're not going to do that to me.'

"I look at myself outside my body and I figure out ways to beat myself. And I'll tell you, it's getting harder and harder to beat me. I look at Tyson and I look at Douglas, and at my best, I'll whip them both.

"All my life I've been fighting. My goal is to be the Heavyweight Champion of the World. It's been 19 years and 11 months that I've been waiting for this fight. This is my ultimate goal."
