### JACKIE ROBINSON'S DIAMOND SAGA IS STILL SHINING.

**Daytona Beach, Fla.**-- The late Jackie Robinson's accomplishments on the green growth of the baseball diamonds continue to shine. In fact so bright, he is still not without honor in his hometown and afar. Perhaps this vacation targeted ocean city, once a "non equality" white haven of signs, "whites" here and "coloreds" there, noticeably those which separated the races, since Robinson touched its watery shores, has become converted and acceptable of the full measures of democracy. On the other side of logic, Daytona was selected as Robinson's headquarters because of the power and respect accorded the late Mary McLeod Bethune, founder of the college, in her name. Returning for the first time since the spring 44 years ago, Rachel Robinson found the trip vastly different. Instead of being plane bounced and shifted to the back of the bus for the final leg of the journey, she and her travelling companion, Betty Adams, president of the Jackie Robinson Foundation, were jet upgraded and pomp and ceremony media greeted upon landing here. "It feels strange being here after all these years," she said. She further iterated that even those who are familiar with the stirring

story of Jackie's triumph over racism were probably not aware how close the great experiment to erase major league baseball's racism came to failure in those trying days. Recalling coming here just three days after her wedding told of the bus trip from Pensacola after again being plane bounced. "The bus driver told her husband to move to the back of the bus. Jackie had always been assertive, but he meekly got up and moved to the back of the bus..." I saw," she said, "how tradition reduced my man to a boy." She further stated that returning after 44 years has given her a fresh perspective and encouragement about the possibility for progress. "This has been a very unique and moving experience for me. Though I am one of these people who never come back. I'm happy I did. I love the statue."

The Jackie Robinson statue idea here is the brain child of Bill Schumann, perhaps one of the best known radio commentators in the Florida broadcast arena. His allegiance to Jackie Robinson was oddly enough nurtured by his grandmother, who was a staunch fan. To show his continuing love and respect for what he called one of democracy's foremost human beings, he started what has developed into one of this city's shining hours, "The Jackie Robinson Statue" marking the entrance to the Jackie Robinson

Baseball Park.
