cards. No matter how poorly or well they do, they should be told that we expect them to do better next semester. We should go to the schools where our children attend and insist that their teachers also expect them to do well. I know that some of these parents cannot be with their children as much as they would like to because they have to work. All such parents should form a neighborhood organization with other parents who are not working and seek out their support.

Blacks should go back to the Black Church where they got their start and receive the spiritual counseling, guidance and fellowship they once got. In times of trouble, such as getting sick and having no one to take care of you, losing everything, having a fire or dying without insurance to bury you. These are just a few ways the Black Church has helped and still helps many Black people today. No other group can honestly make the claim of the Black Church. Why don't you join a church today?

Since 1909 the NAACP has been working with the Black family and the Black Church in search of equal opportunity and fairness in education, employment, housing and public accommodations. Blacks must understand that if there was no NAACP there is a great likelihood that they could not live very comfortably in Nevada in the lifestyle they have learned to expect. School District Administrators Set To Teach

Administrators throughout the Clark County School District have been requested by Superintendent Brian Cram to spend at least one day per semester teaching students during the 1990-91 school year.

"There is nothing that we do in this school system at the staff level that is as important as the instruction teachers provide to students in the classroom," Cram said. "That's why we think it is vitally important for central office and field administrators to spend quality time working directly with the students whose interest we serve."

Cram, in a recent memo, further stated, "Administrators who are certified to teach should assume total responsibility for lesson planning and instruction, while non-certified administrators may make arrangements to assist the regular instructor." The superintendent left it up to each administrator's discretion to facilitate the teaching experience.

However, Cram did request for administrators

who primary assignment is at a school to schedule their teaching experience at another school. Otherwise, administrators are free to select any school, teacher, grade level, and content area.

"I want all school district managers to experience firsthand what it's like to actually work on a lesson plan and help teach students today. It is important for all of us in the education profession to be familiar with the classroom because that's our number one focus," emphasized Cram.

Bob Broniecki, president of the Clark County Classroom Teachers Association commended Cram for requesting administrators to teach.

"Teachers today must cope with a whole set of social problems - gangs, drugs, lack of parental supervision - that weren't there ten or even five years ago," Broniecki said. "It's important that administrators see first-hand how these problems affect the classroom. This classroom experience will help them be more effective administrators."
