Proposals shall be submitted on the sheets bound in the Contract Volume. and the complete Contract Volume submitted to comprise a complete bid.

The work consists of approximately 696 horizontal linear feet of six (5) inch inside diameter pipe, replacement of 15 water service assemblies, installation of two (2) new fire hydrants, three (3) new one (1) inch diameter water service assemblies, and the installation of all related fittings. valves and appurtenances. Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes, Chapter 368, bidders are hereby notified that the prevailing wage rates established by the Nevada State Labor Commissioner must be paid to all work-men engaged in the performance of any works construction contracts awarded for the amount of \$100,000.00 or more.
