REV. J.C. COLEMAN DIES AT AGE 96

The Reverend J.C. Coleman, a 48 year resident of Las Vegas, and a prominent figure in the community, died October 24. He was 96. An Army Veteran of World War I, he was born March 10, 1894 in Edwards, Mississippi. He moved to Las Vegas in 1942, where he worked for the American Potash Plant for 20 years until his retirement in 1965.

Reverend Coleman founded the New Hope Baptist Church in Las Vegas, where he also was pastor for 36 years. The Reverend Coleman was instrumental in the development of young promising ministers.

He was a member of the Pride of The West District Association, The Nevada/California State Baptist Convention, and the National Baptist Convention under the late J.H. Jackson, and a member of the Christian Fellowship. He lent total support to most Christian activities in Nevada. Reverend Coleman was also a 33rd Degree Mason, St. Paul Lodge #2 A.F. & A.M. of the Shriners Medina Temple.

He is survived by his wife, 1 son, 3 daughters, 23 grandchildren, 29 great grandchildren and a host of friends.

Funeral services will be held at Victory Baptist Church, 500 W. Monroe, Saturday Nov. 3, at 11:00 a.m.

Viewing will be at Palm Mortuary, 1325 North Main, Nov. 2, from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. The body will also be lying in state at New Hope Baptist Church, 3737 E. Glen, from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.



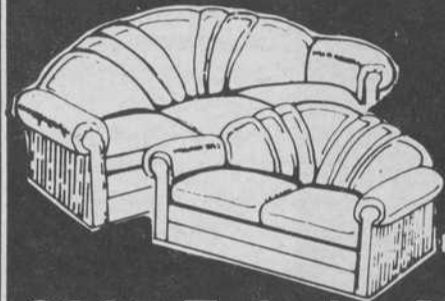
