ALADDIN TO FEATURE FATTBURGER AT GRAND OPENING OF JAZZ

The popular California jazz group, **FATTBURGER**, that brought their first Intima album (Good News) and its follow-up (Living in Paradise) to the top ten on Billboard jazz charts, is scheduled to perform November 23-24 as part of the grand opening of **JAZZ** at the Aladdin Hotel & Casino.

The brainchild of Tim Dougall, General Manager of the Aladdin, **JAZZ** will feature quality jazz entertainment nightly (with Sundays on a TBA basis) and a headliner group every three weeks. The club, which seats 175 people in a cozy atmosphere conducive to jazz listening, will have a full service bar and finger foods. On nights when the house bands are appearing, there will be a two drink minimum, and on headliner nights there will be a cover charge.

The hours for **JAZZ** are 9:30

p.m. to 3:30 a.m. Doors will open at 9:30 p.m. with scheduled sets on regular nights at 10:00 p.m., 11:20 p.m., 12:40 a.m., and 2:00 a.m. Performances for headliners will be from 10:00-11:15 p.m. and 12:30-1:45 a.m.

JAZZ will showcase **CALDEIRA** featuring **Paul Christopher** on Monday, November 19; **THE PRESS** on Tuesday, November 20; **KAREN NELSON BELL & COMPANY** on Wednesday, November 21; (**DARK ON THANKSGIVING**); **FATTBURGER** on November 23-24; **TEX RICHARDSON & KATHY LAMAR** on Sunday,

November 25; **CALDEIRA** featuring **Paul Christopher** will perform Monday through Saturday starting November 26th; Sundays TBA.

FATTBURGER, a San Diego based jazz group, played to a sell out crowd the last time they were in Vegas and is expected to do the same this time around. Their newest **Enigma** album, **COME AND GET IT**, is one of the most request contemporary jazz albums on radio today.

To pick a standout track from any of their albums is sure to be an impossible task, but you can

be sure that you will hear some favorites such as "Oh Girl," a remake of the number one hit for the Chi-Lites back in 1972; "Monica," "Any Two Can Play," along with such sassy, fusionistic songs as "Who Put the Meat in My Bed," and "Back to Jersey".
