In Accordance with this year's theme "Living the Dream to Save the Children", young vocalists of the Second Baptist Choir filled the church with song and joy.



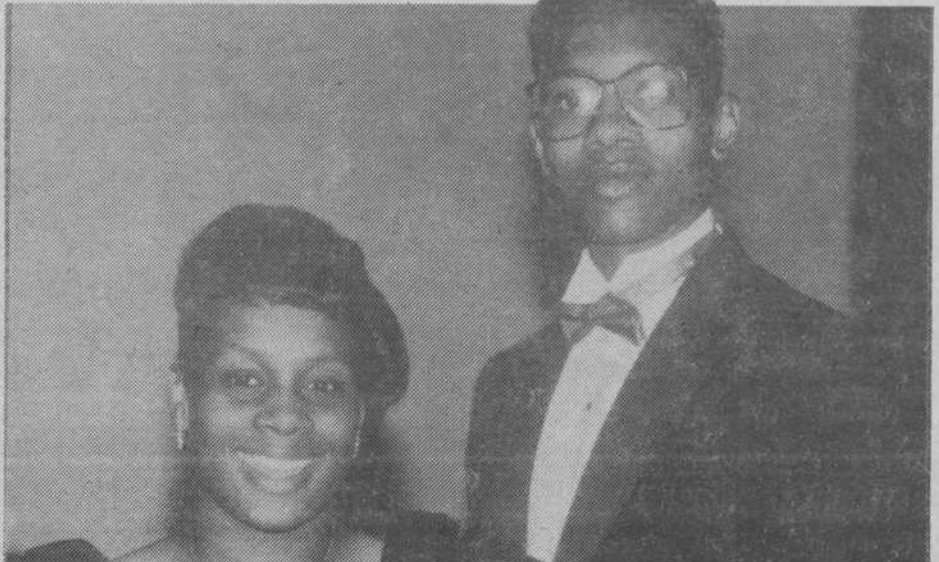
Guest speaker of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Banquet, E. Fay Williams, delivered an unforgettable message to the more than five hundred in attendance.
