## BELL BIV DeVOE WIN TWO AMERICAN MUSIC AWARDS

Bell Biv DeVoe — whose debut MCA Records album, <u>Poison</u>, recently went Triple Platinum — have added to their success, winning two awards at the 18th Annual American Music Awards ceremonies, held January 28 at the Shrine Auditorium in Los Angeles.

Bell Biv DeVoe, featuring New Edition members Ricky Bell, Michael Bivins and Ronnie DeVoe, were voted Favorite New Soul/Rhythm & blues Artist and Favorite New Dance Music Artist. They were also nominated in two other AMA categories: Favorite Pop/Rock Band and Fa-




vorite Pop/Rock Band and Favorite Soul/Rhythm & Blues

The American Music Awards are selected by the public, with 20,000 ballots sentout to a cross-section of individuals across America. Two other MCA Recording Artists won AMAs: Reba McEntire, for Favorite Country Album (Reba Live) and Favorite Country Female Artist, and George Strait, for Favorite Country Male Artist.

When nominations for the Fifth Annual Soul Train Music Awards were announced recently, Bell Biv DeVoe were nominated in two categories. Best R & B/Urban Contemporary Single ("Poison"), Group or Duo and R & B/Urban Contemporary Album of the Year (Poison), Group or Duo.

The five month, 80-city, North American Triple Threat Tour, featuring co-headliners Bell Biv DeVoe, Johnny Gill and Keith Sweat, has been garnering lots of press attention, with most of the words of praise being directed at BBD. A USA Today review of the Philadelphia Spectrum show noted, "With a smart blend of rap and R & B and outrageous stage antics, Bell Biv DeVoe surprising steal the show." The USA Today reviewer goes on to call the BBD set an "energetic, stylized perform-
