ability, and The Man Upstairs will take care of the rest." "AMEN!" Regarding STARDOM, LENA HORNE would often remark, "IT'S TOUGHER TO STAY THERE THEN TO GET THERE!"

Someone who will always BE THERE in our hearts and minds is MR. SAMMY DAVIS JR. SAMMY was "NEVER FAR FROM HOME," and he would remindall, "IDON'T CARE HOW BIG YOU GET, SOMEONE WILL ALWAYS BE THERE TO REMIND YOU THAT YOU ARE BLACK! What can I say about MS. PEARLIE MEA, PEARL BAILEY. MS BAILEY, and what she stood for is truly the cherry I wish to TOP off this column on. With her finger pointed towards each and every one of us, MS. ## HERBIE HANCOCK SCORES ARGE" FOR GOLDWYN

Oscar and three-time Grammy-winner Herbie Hancock has been signed by executive producer David Picker to write, compose and perform the score for Michael Schultz's LIVIN' LARGE!, a comedy to be released this summer by the Samuel Goldwyn

Shot on location in Atlanta, Georgia, the film stars T.C. Carson as Dexter Jackson, a young black student at the Ajax School of Broadcasting, who gets the scoop of a lifetime that lands him a newscasting job at the local network affiliate. In the wake of his success, Dexter leaves more than a few battered relationships and part of his identity as he tries to capture his dreams. Directed and produced by Shultz, who directed the successful Broadway black musical "MULE BONE" as well as KRUSH GROOVE, CAR WASH and COOLEY HIGH, among others, LIVIN' LARGE is written by William Mosley Payne.

The multi-award-winning Hancock picked up a 1986 Academy Award for Best Original Score for the motion picture 'ROUND MIDNIGHT. His other film scores include, COLORS, BLOW-UP, A SOLDIER'S STORY, DEATH WISH.


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
