Star Athlete Killed In Shooting Spree

Calvin Long, a former all-star, first team football player at Bonanza High School, was shot to death early Tuesday morning as he slept in the back seat of a friends car. The killing was part of a shooting spree near Princeton Street in North Las Vegas that also left 20-year-old Eric Eackles dead and a 16-year-old youth seriously injured.

Long, a promising 19-yearold wide receiver, was due to return to Dixie Jr. College is St. George, Utah, for his second season, at the end of the week.

Terrance Eackles, also 19, said he and Long had gone out to eat Monday night before giving Eric Eackles, his brother, a ride to a friends house.

The pair dropped Eric off at a house on Princeton St. and planned to drive around while he changed his clothes, then come back to pick him up.

As Terrance pulled off around the corner near Lake Mead Blvd., he said he heard approximately 10 gunshots and stopped the car. Seconds later more shots were fired, and he looked back to find Long dead in the back seat with a bullet wound to the back of the head.

Terrance Eackles then quickly returned to Princeton St.,

where he found his brother, Eric, shot in the side of his head.

The 16-year-old youth was standing outside when the shooting occurred, and was shot in the eye. He was last listed in serious but stable condition at University Medicare Center.

The police department has once again labeled the incident as "gang related," which has angered the Eackles family.

Police, who are looking for a red, early 80's model Chevolet Caprice seen near Princeton St., shortly before the shooting, said they have no suspects in the shootings and have received conflicting reports from witnesses.
