The women interviewed were European-American, Italian-American, Iranian-American and African-American widowed by an Hispanic-American. The African-American woman told the audience about the racism she experienced prior to her husband's death, in raising their

The women interviewed did feel the racial tension that socias well as the non-acceptance by their family members however, this did not bother them.

The audience raised eyebrows with some questions about the need for African-American men to stick by his African - American woman .. One questioner from the audience said that when an African-American man can speak well, think well and is well educated it seems that the African-American woman is no longer desirable.
