North Las Vegas water customers who bring their September utility bill to City Hall will receive a free low-flow shower head.

The notice states: SAVE MONEY! CONSERVE WATER! YOU CAN GET A FREE LOW-FLOW SHOWER HEAD WHEN YOU BRING THIS BILL TO NORTH LAS VEGAS CITY HALL. HURRY—WHILE SUPPLIES LAST! FIRST COME—FIRST SERVED!

The shower heads are easily installed on the standard shower and will reduce the water flow rate to 2.75 gallons per minute.

"Water conservation is a top priority in our City," said Councilman W. Brent Hardy, "and we believe that this sort of program, along with education, will help to make a difference."

A notice of availability will go out to all water customers in the City for the demonstration program, but the low-flow shower heads will be distributed on a first-come, first-serve basis.

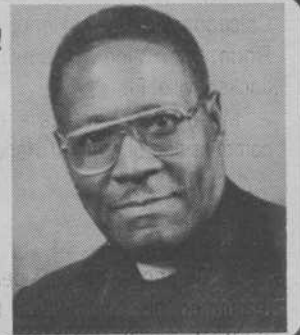

RESOLUTION SUBMITTED UNDER ARTICLE X, SECTION 2 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE NAACP 1991 — PART VII

7. Resolution on Tuskegee Airmen Approved

WHEREAS, the Tuskegee Airmen were the first black participants in United States military aviation; and,

WHEREAS, the 99th Pursuit Squadron, commanded by Lt. Cl. Benjamin O. Davis, Jr., established a brilliant record of service and victory in the battle skies over Europe in World War II; and,

WHEREAS, the Tuskegee Airmen played an important role in establishing unquestioned precedents of ability and skill in military aviation and paved the way for new opportunities for African-Americans and for more cooperative race relations in the United States Armed Forces and in all aspects of American life; and,

WHEREAS, the efforts of the Tuskegee Airmen has become the common property of all Americans and must be shared with the present generation and those yet unborn; and,

WHEREAS, the rich

legacy of the Tuskegee Airmen has become the common property of all Americans and must be shared with the present generation and those yet unborn; and

WHEREAS, the NAACP advocated and supported the total utilization of black Americans in the American Military, and mobilized all of its resources in a crusade to secure the training of young black men as pilots in the Army Air Force;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that in the occasion of the 50th Anniversary of the Tuskegee Airmen; the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, assembled in the 82nd National Convention of the NAACP, does laud and honor the Tuskegee Airmen International for duty well done in the defense of the United States and the rights and freedoms of all humankind, and for being pioneers, and for having served in a manner that reflected the dignity, pride and patriotism of African-Americans.
