(Continued from Page 9) lives by saying, "I may not be as good as my boss (wife, husband etc.") but I know that I am better than any black person." This is the psychological value that blacks have for many white people. It also allows for the government to refrain from spending the funds that would be necessary for the elimination of racism.

Many blacks tend to desire to live in communities separate from whites because of the psychological trauma that they must endure in order to carry on daily activities in contact with white people. Whites generally do not want to mingle with blacks, and blacks know it.

Yet blacks, fear retribution (job loss, incarceration, loss of an apartment) if they make their feelings known. So they keep their anger locked up within them. Except when they are in the company of other blacks. This is the psychological trauma experienced by all blacks.

It is an "Invisible Race Riot."

The depth of racial hatred, for blacks and whites, is almost frightening. Blacks who have attended predominantly white colleges are not surprised to have the word "nigger" written on their dormitory doors. Or to have whites get up and leave a cafeteria or library table when they sit down. Or have a college professor completely ignore them when they raise their hands to speak.

Black students are rushing to leave white colleges and enroll in black schools. Re-segregation is, apparently, desired by blacks and whites in every echelon of society.

I agree with the gentleman who said that some of his best friends were white. Some of mine are, also. However, the reality of the Big picture is one of racial hatred. Many people do not like to hear or speak the unfortunate reality of America because it goes against the so called principles of democracy. but the facts operate daily on the streets. An Invisible Race Riot is

taking place. Actual racial violence takes place in the dark of night.

However, <u>psychological</u> racial violence takes place during most encounters between blacks and whites. They would probably destroy each other, if they could get away with it.

If you understand the permanent segreation of American society, you can understand the dynamics of the struggle by blacks in South Africa for complete democracy. South African blacks should not and will not accept anything short of a society run by the majority population of blacks, American blacks had an opportunity to restructure American society in the 1960s.

Our time for a truly democratic society has passed. We made great social advancement but because of our complacency and trust in democracy, allowed it to slip through our fingers. Perhaps someday, we can glory in a South Africa run by truly free black people.
