This work will be a performance contract to provide a fully operational system which meets all Federal, State and local codes and standards for a fuel storage and service at NLVAT.

The work includes supply and installation of two self-contained above ground fuel tanks with necessary power and pumps. One 20,000 gallon tank will be installed for Avgas service. The second fuel tank will be 15,000 gallons with two compaarments one for jet fuel and another for vehicle fuel. The 20,000 gallon tank will be connected by fuel lines to a 50' diameter raised concrete self-service island on a 150'x150' concrete pad. The island will have a shade canopy, overhead lights and a twenty-four hour fuel dispenising system for both credit card and self-serv-

The work, includes underground installation of the necessary fuel lines, and plumbing and electrical to make the system

A fuel management system will be lo-cated at the 20,000 gallon tank only. This system will gather product level in the tank, water level, delivery, inventory and leak detection information. A remote monitoring station will be provided within the Terminal Building.

An alternate to the work consists of the Owner electing to have the Contractor supply and install lights on the edge of the 50' raised island.
