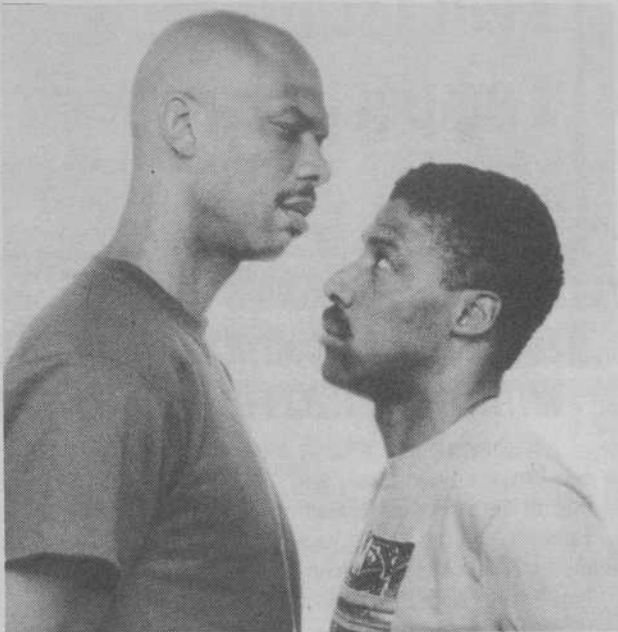


# "CLASH OF THE LEGENDS" WILL BENEFIT AIDS-RELATED CHARITIES



Julius Erving, Kareem Abdul Jabbar and the DJ Group, presenter of the Feb. 28 "Clash of the Legends" one-on-one basketball challenge, will donate part of the proceeds from the pay-per-view cable television event to AIDS-related charities.

With each purchase of the event by a cable subscriber, 50 cents will be donated. Half will go to the American Foundation

for AIDS Research, the nation's leading non-profit organization dedicated to AIDS research, education and public policy. Since 1985, AMFAR has provided more than \$39 million to more than 620 of these projects.

The other half of the contributions will go to the Magic Johnson Foundation, a charity recently established by Magic Johnson to assist in the battle

against the HIV virus.

The "Clash of the Legends," pitting Erving against Abdul Jabbar in the main event, will be televised live on pay-per-view cable television from Trump Taj

Mahal in Atlantic City, NJ, at 9 p.m. (ET)/ 6 p.m. (PT), with a replay immediately following.

In addition to the featured duel, four other NBA legends to be announced later will compete

in a one-on-one tournament format, presented by the DJ Group, Inc. in association with Trump Taj Mahal and SET Pay Per View, which is distributing the event to the cable and televi-

sion industries.

Games will be played on a half court, with a three-point line and a 12-second shot clock. Veteran NBA referee Earl Strom will officiate the game.

### Rebel Softball Team Rated No. 8

UNLV's softball team is ranked No. 8 in the nation in the preseason poll.

The Rebels are coming off a 49-17-1 season. The 49 wins are the most in school history.

UNLV finished second in the Big West Conference with a 25-8-1 record. It made its second straight appearance in the College World Series.

Senior Lori Harrigan (24-11, 0.58 ERA) and junior Kim Smith (25-6, 0.68) return to the Rebels' pitching staff.

### UNLV Ranked Fourth In Track

The UNLV women's track team has opened the 1992 season ranked fourth in the country, its highest national rating ever.

Florida, Louisiana State and Villanova are ranked ahead of the Lady Rebels, who opened their season last week with a dual meet sweep over Air Force and Adams State.

The starting Senior hails out of Compton, California and has been playing basketball for about 10 years. "It was my #1 hobby when I was younger. I played at Compton High and narrowed my choices down to Long Beach St. and UNLV. I wanted to leave my social life so I knew I had to leave California," explains Shay, as she is nicknamed, at a recent practice.

Sharon sees her team maturing eventually, "we just need more playing time together. If we all play to our potential, for the rest of the season, we will be ready for the Big West Tourney.

"Right now, I need to stop making silly turnovers and missing easy layups," adds Hargrove.

Shay scored a career-high, 26 points, against then-ranked #12 Louisiana State.

Although she said that her best would be against Long Beach St., she still didn't look to shabby.

Before fouling out, Shay scored 18, hitting 57% (8-14) from the field, dished out 7 assists and pulled down 10 rebounds.

The Rebels have 12 games remaining, 11 in the Big West,

including 1 more against Long Beach State on February 29th, a game that could decide the Big West regular-season title.

UNLV returns home for a doubleheader, with the Men's team, on Thursday February 13. The ladies will face New Mexico St. at 5:30 and the men will battle San Jose St at 8:05.

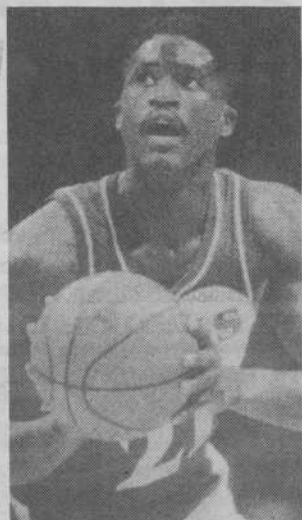
