(Continued from Page 9) raped a women less than half his size without leaving a single bruise on her body.

Fuller suggested the teenager's rape claim resulted from Tyson not continuing a relationship with her.

"(She) suddenly realizes she has been treated like a onenight stand. Her dignity is offended," he said. "I submit to you (the teenager) was rudely treated. She was embarrassed and humiliated by her own conduct."

Indianapolis attorney Gregory Garrison had the opportunity to address the jury last through the prosecution's rebuttal. Garrison told the jury the defense has focused on Tyson's accuser to avoid his own guilty conduct.

"We need to open the doors and turn on a big fan and blow all of Mr. Fuller's smoke out of here," he said.

"Date rape is not half a crime. It is a violent crime against women and one that every man need to recognize."

He also gave the jury a sense of the impact their decision would have

you know that," he said. "The world wants to know if the people of Marion County have the courage to do the right thing."

"There you have your wild-Indian sexual monster," he said. She wants to take her roommate to watch."
