In God We Trust...For Tru

Are there in 1992 any absolute truths to live by? Ones so tender in meaning and powerful in effect that our lives can experience higher freedoms as black people in America? We can read the eloquent truths declared as self evident in the 1776 Congress, but its heart-stirring words were not meant to include us. Still even now, we cannot rely on the nation's sense of racial justice or gratitude for our contributions as black people. Our only hope is that the measure of real truth is determined by God and not by man. What we choose to believe

as black people in America has anultimate influence on our lives. The search for truth is however less widely pursured than ways of deception. Each of us needs to find a standard for truth that is larger than our lives, yet personal as the air we breathe. And its source must be one whose evidence can stand the test of time as a surety of trustworthiness. In 2 Chronicles 20:20, we are counseled to Believe in the Lord, your God, so shall ye be established, believe in his prophets, so shall ve prosper.

One of the most absolute truths that we experience each sleep. It is a fact of life to which we are so accustomed that we may not realize its wonder nor its testimony as the will of God. Our chances for fulfillment each day are very much a part of the gratitude we show for another gift of life. No matter what our daily struggles in a nation that tends to de-value black life, we can pray to overcome the odds, and then find positive answers that make a difference in our lives. For God hath not given us the spirit of fear: but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind, according to 2 Timothy 1:7. That assurance only works for those of us who believe it ...

We may be uncertain about having all the absolute truths to live by, but we can surely seek to know them from the infallible source provided: The Bible. It is the only book, combined with study and prayer, that communicates the will of God to us. It tells of God, creator and ruler of the universe, who is the organ of love and truth and eternal life. It tells how sin and deception became the human transgressions that are still incompatible to God. Yet it gives us prophecies of God's plan of redemption for believers who trust in Him. The plan of redemption is the gospel of hope left by Jesus Christ, for according to John 3:17, God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world: but that the world through him might be saved. We need to know for ourselves what is promised in that salvation.
